Mentoring Program

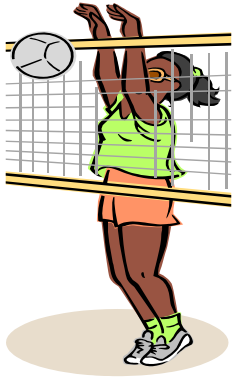

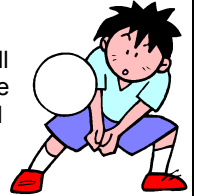

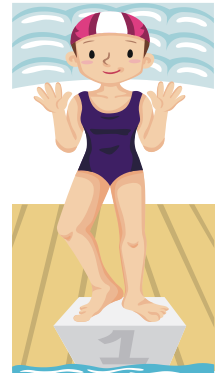
