Supply List 2011-12 School Year SCHOOL SUPPLIES

7th and 8th Grade Supply List

- Book to read for pleasure either from home or from the public library (no magazines)
- Brown paper bags to be used as book covers. (Material/fabric book covers do not protect the textbooks and should not be used.)
- Colored pencils
- Tab dividers (8 tabs)
- Markers-thick and thin
- Wide-lined loose-leaf paper
- Wide-lined spiral notebooks for each class (some may require 2)
- 2 pocket folders for each class
- No. 2 pencils
- Red, blue and black pens
- Glue stick and a glue bottle
- German - German/English (paperback) pocket dictionary
- French - one 3 subject notebook and folder specifically for French class
- Spanish – one small 3 ring binder with 4 tab dividers
- Protractor
- 7th Grade only: Two – thick dry erase markers
- Graph paper notebook [1/4” squares] both 7th & 8th grade students. (Math, Algebra, Geometry and Science students)
- Compass (with a wheel to hold the position in place)
- Scissors
- Goggles (*District approved with indirect venting.*) May be purchased from Science teachers for \$5.00
- Heart Rate Monitor Strap – (Will be available for purchase during summer Registration in August for \$8.00. Previously purchased Heart Rate Monitor Straps may be re-used.)
- Orchestra: Both 7th and 8th grade students bring instruments on the **SECOND** day of class.
- 2 boxes facial tissue (to be given to their homeroom teacher)
- 4 x 6 note cards
- 256MB Flashdrive (Order forms will be available in the LMC during summer registration. Cost: \$15.00 each.)
- Earbuds or headphones with a computer jack for a PC
- White, 1 inch, three ring binder (to be used as the *Research Binder*) for all incoming 7th Graders & all *new* 8th Graders to Einstein
- Highlighters-two colors
- Ruler
- Locker organizer, mirror, “Tack It” (optional)
- Transparent tape
- Scientific calculator for Math classes:
 - Needs to be able to calculate with fractions, powers, square roots and be solar powered

- Physical Education Clothing: T-Shirt, gym type shorts, tennis shoes, brush/comb, deodorant (non aerosol)
