The Appleton Area School District is encouraging all families to participate in screenings for all children ages 3 to 5 that are not enrolled in kindergarten. The developmental screening looks at all areas of child development including: fine motor skills, gross motor skills, speech and language skills, thinking and learning skills. This is your child's "other check-up" to make sure your child's development is on track; so when the time comes, your child will be ready for kindergarten.



All children ages 3, 4 and 5 that are not already enrolled in kindergarten are eligible to participate in the Appleton Area School District developmental screenings. Students already enrolled in the kindergarten are not eligible to participate in the developmental screenings. If your child has already participated in a screening, you do not need to schedule another appointment; however, if you have concerns or would like your child screened again, please feel free to make an appointment.
