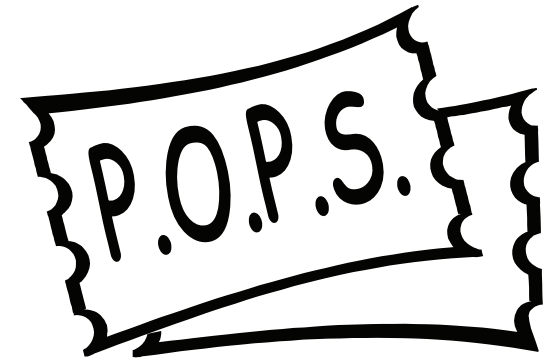


What is a P.O.P.S. Ticket?

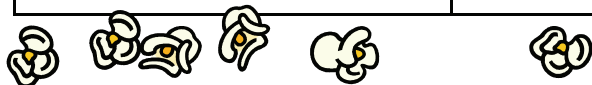

How Do I Cash

in My Tickets

1. Collect the required amount tickets.
2. Pick-up a menu from your classroom.

5. A fourth grade student will pick up the completed menu the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month.
6. You will be contacted by a staff member once a date and time is set for your reward.
