Appleton Elementary Summer School Course Descriptions

****When looking at grade level, use grade entering in fall.*

Kindergarten Readiness

\$10.00 fee

Grade K

This course is designed to introduce and/or reinforce basic readiness skills for kindergarten. *Class meets from 8:30-11:30*

Building Blocks for 1st Grade

\$5.00 fee

Grade 1

A course designed for children who have completed kindergarten and could use more readiness experience before 1st grade. Reading, writing, and arithmetic are but a few of the activities/skills provided.

2nd - 3rd Grade Math Practice

\$5.00 fee

Grade 2-3

For students who need additional practice with counting, recognizing coins, basic addition and subtraction, telling time, place value, and basic word problems.

4th - 5th Grade Math Practice

\$5.00 fee

Grades 4-5

This course is designed for students who need extra help with basic math concepts and skills such as adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing, place value, telling time, identifying and counting money, and solving story problems.

6th - 7th Grade Math Practice

\$5.00 fee

Grades 6-7

This course is designed for students who need extra help with basic math concepts and skills such as multiplication and division, telling time, working with fractions, counting money and making change, and solving story problems.

2nd Grade Reading Practice

\$5.00 fee

Grade 2

For students who need additional practice with basic sight words, phonics, identifying letters, understanding what they have read, vocabulary building, and writing as it relates to all of these areas.

3rd - 4th Grade Reading Practice

\$5.00 fee

Grades 3-4

This course is designed to help students with basic phonics and decoding skills, with knowing and applying basic reading comprehension strategies, and with the basic mechanics of writing sentences including punctuation and sentence structure.

5th - 7th Grade Reading Practice

\$5.00 fee

Grades 5-7

This course is designed to help students with basic reading comprehension strategies and with the basics of writing sentences, paragraphs, and stories.

Books are Summer Fun

\$5.00 fee

Grades 1-3 & Grades 4-6

Students will experience the world of books through a variety of creative activities intended to develop and broaden their appreciation for and love of good literature.

Primary Nature Detectives

\$10.00 fee

Grades 1-3

Activities are designed in a hands-on approach that includes many aspects of the world of science with emphasis on insects, plants, and animals.

Intermediate Science Wonders

\$10.00 fee

Grades 4-7

Activities are designed to give a hands-on approach to a variety of subject areas on the world of science.

Primary Computers

\$10.00 fee

Grades 1-3

Students will continue to develop general computer skills and knowledge of computers. Microsoft Word, Kidspiration and Powerpoint, will be used and students will learn how to use student safe internet sites for research as well as e-mail for communication.

Intermediate Computer Lab

\$10.00 fee

Grades 3-7

Students will learn how to use the Internet, use various Microsoft programs that are very useful for personal and school projects such as PowerPoint and Word, and improve their keyboarding skills.

Advance Intermediate Computer Lab

\$10.00 fee

Grades 4-7

Must have previously taken Intermediate Computer Lab. Students will continue to explore the many different Microsoft computer programs, create projects, and use of the Internet.

Beginning Spanish

\$5.00 fee

Grades 1-3 and Grade 4-7

This course will introduce students to basic Spanish and vocabulary. It will also focus on the culture of Spanish-speaking countries.

Spanish II

\$5.00 fee

Grades 4-7

Must have previously taken Beginning Spanish, this course will continue to teach students the Spanish vocabulary and more.

Beginning Creative Woodshop

\$10.00 fee

Grades 1-7

Basic use of non-power woodworking tools for sawing, sanding, assembling, and finishing. The beginner's class is for those children with little or no experience with using hand tools. Parents are encouraged to provide leather gloves for their child to help guard against splinters and abrasions.

Advanced Creative Woodshop

\$10.00 fee

Grades 1-7

Advanced woodworking is for those children who are pretty capable of using a hammer and hand saw to make things out of wood. Parents are encouraged to provide leather gloves for their child to help guard against splinters and abrasions. Projects done last year will be repeated again this year.

Primary Games Galore

Grades 1-3

Intermediate Games Galore

\$5.00 fee

Grades 4-7

Students will experience a variety of physical education games, activities, and skills.

Primary Arts and Crafts

\$10.00 fee

Grades 1-3

Intermediate Arts and Crafts

\$10.00 fee

Grades 4-7

May include indoor and outdoor drawing, sketching, painting, clay and other projects as selected by the teacher.

Little Theatre

\$10.00 fee

Grades 1-3 and Grades 4-7

This course is designed for the student who likes to put on plays, do improvisations, act out dramatic situations, and pantomime. Basic stage and theatre concepts will also be taught while encouraging and providing an outlet for the dramatically creative side of the children's personalities.

Scrapbooking/Stamping
