Choir Camp Content: This camp will provide the student with a rich variety of musical experiences. Some of the things that students will learn/experience are: developing their musical ears, developing their ability to read music from the printed score, learning to follow a printed octavo, learning to use movement and facial expressions to communicate with the audience, studying the voice as an instrument, using folksongs as a medium for story telling through music and refining music for the concert on the last day of class. CLASS CONTENT Elementary Music Camp 2019

(selected from the following)

Ear Training: A basic general music class for students interesting in developing their musical ears. The focus will be tonal memory, melody, and rhythm patterns.

Sight Singing: A basic general music class for students interested in developing their ability to read music from the printed score. Concepts such as Major Key, Solfegio, and musical intervals will be studied.

Note Reading: A grass-roots level class in following a printed octavo. Terms such as *grand staff, repeat, fine,* and *da capo* will be studied.

Acting Class: A dynamic class in performance for singers. Techniques such as physical alignment, movement, facial expression, and text communication will be studied.

Dance Class: Movement through music will be studied in this class. Students will explore the basics dance techniques and understandings as they apply to music performance.

Voice Class: The voice will be studied as an instrument. Healthy singing, tone color (timbre), breathing, support, vowel placement, consonants, will be some of the subject covered in this class.

Folksongs: This class will use the extensive folksong repertoire as a medium for story telling through music. Unison and part songs will be our text books.

Choir Sectionals/Rehearsal: A traditional chorus setting where music is studied, created, and refined for concert performance on the last day of the camp.

CLASS CONTENT

The Singing Actor: A dynamic class in performance for singers. Techniques such as physical alignment, movement, facial expression, and text communication will be studied.
