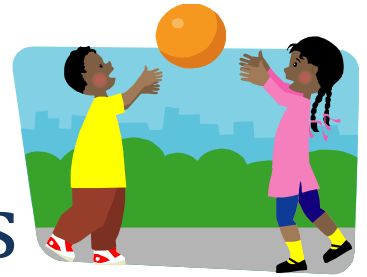


3-5 Year Old Developmental Screenings

ALL children participate in a developmental screening:

- Children should be screened on or after their 3rd birthday
- We prefer to see children at age 3 and before entering 4K
- If your child is currently attending 4K, and has not been screened, please contact us to schedule an appointment.
