The Fox Cities Leadership Academy understands that the demands of secondary education and the workforce expect significant levels of ability attributed to career based learning and “soft skills.” By incorporating an interdisciplinary learning curriculum, standards based assessment, and the relevance of real world experiential learning, the FCLA is able to impress upon its students the

ability to adapt and succeed in their future endeavors. Students learn to work in groups, interact with adults, plan, create, and assess relevant work experience, present amongst peers as well as outside professionals, self-motivate, lead, and participate in insightful discussion and analysis. Students in the FCLA leave at graduation with a Department of Public Instruction Leadership skills

certificate and defend their experiences in a portfolio laden interview evaluated by outside professionals. Students leave with an assortment of life plans and are ready for the inevitable challenge of change. Individuals are ready for the next level of education or workforce development with experiences in their field or research into their chosen passion or future.

Accomplishments of the FCLA

Nationally Recognized in 2016

We were awarded **Newsweek America’s Top High Schools of 2015 and now in 2016!** We were also awarded **US News and World Report’s Best High Schools in 2015.**

Awards were received by an analysis of school demographics and counselors, college acceptance and enrollment, ACT performance, and AP course participation. We received confirmation that we were ranked #430 of the top 500 schools in the nation. The ACA was one of the 20 Wisconsin high schools cited.

We also achieved another honor from Newsweek as well.

Newsweek’s “Beating the Odds” list seeks to identify schools that do an excellent job of preparing their students for college while also overcoming the obstacles posed by students at an economic

disadvantage. The FCLA also made that list at school ranking #230.

Our Seniors earn the Department of Public Instruction Leadership Certificate

Over 90% of our graduating Seniors earn the Department of Public Instruction Leadership Certificate by documenting those fourteen leadership traits within their personal portfolios.

AP Pacesetter School

The FCLA has been recognized as an Advanced Placement Pacesetter School for our Advanced Placement scores.

In the year of 2014-15, the Fox Cities Leadership Academy had 30 Seniors in its class. Of the 30, 14 took at least 1 AP course. Of those 14 students, 9 took an AP exam in its content. 8 of those 9 scored a 3 or higher on the exam.
