Wilson has continued its work with Positive Behavior, Interventions, and Supports (PBIS), being named a Bronze award winner for the 16/17 school year.

Student positive behavior is reinforced in a variety of ways, including monthly all-school celebrations or reward incentives. One celebration we are especially proud of is our November assembly, where students earn the opportunity to duct tape the principal to the wall by bringing in canned good items. Wilson has had one of the most successful canned food drives in

the school system, and we are proud our students know the importance of giving. Also, Wilson has a number of academic supports for students who need additional help as they work toward personal success. Teams of teachers meet weekly to monitor student concerns, and students are given daily support in areas where they need an extra hand.

Opportunities at Wilson

Wilson is proud to provide many opportunities for its students to succeed. Whether it is the aforementioned behavioral and academic supports or whether it is "Learning beyond the Classroom" through extra-curricular activities and clubs, Wilson has something for everyone.

Through a partnership with the Boys and Girls Club, Wilson has a before and after school program where kids get homework help and do fun activities like robotics.

One of the growing opportunities is the Raider Round-Ups led by teacher leader Tony Martin, where students and families get to have "good old fashioned family fun" such as roller skating, drive-in movies and even ice-fishing.
