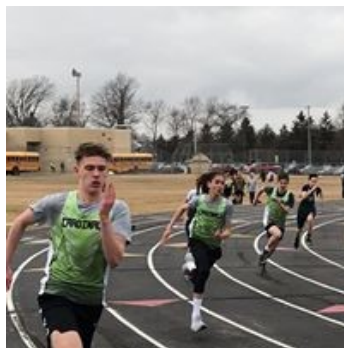
The curriculum is delivered through inquiry-based activities and projects arranged in interdisciplinary two-teacher teams.
