Expectations: The children are expected to attend camp each day to enjoy this camp to its fullest. All AASD policies for the regular academic school year regarding dress, behavior, etc., are in effect during summer school. Copies of the AASD behavior policies are available upon request.

Choir Camp Content: This camp will provide the student with a rich variety of musical experiences. Some of the things that students will learn/experience are: developing their musical ears, developing their ability to read music from the printed score, learning to follow a printed octavo, learning to use movement and facial expressions to communicate with the audience, studying the voice as an instrument, using folksongs as a medium for story telling through music and refining music for the concert on the last day of class. CLASS CONTENT

(selected from the following)

Theatre Class: A dynamic class in performance for singers. Techniques such as physical alignment, movement, facial expression, and text communication will be studied. As well, students will learn how to audition for roles on stage

Dance Class: Movement through music will be studied in this class. Students will explore the basics dance techniques and understandings as they apply to music performance.

Voice Class: The voice will be studied as an instrument. Healthy singing, tone color (timbre), breathing, support, vowel placement, consonants, will be some of the subject covered in this class.

Folksongs: This class will use the extensive folksong repertoire as a medium for story telling through music. Unison and part songs will be our text books.

Choir Sectionals/Rehearsal: A traditional chorus setting where music is studied, created, and refined for concert performance on the last day of the camp.
