PAYMENT INFORMATION:

- Payment is ***required to complete registration***
- The Summer School Software requires payment in order to complete the registration. ***Therefore, your child will not be registered in a course if payment is not made online via debit/credit card.***

CLASS CANCELLATIONS:

A course may be cancelled if there is insufficient enrollment. If this happens, you will be notified by email or phone.

OPEN HOUSE:

We will be hosting an Open House on Monday June 10, from 4:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. The Summer School Leadership Team and Student Volunteers will be available to assist students and parents in locating classrooms and answer questions. Please note that teachers will not be present during the Open House.

Color Guard Basics/Advanced Drum Line/Marching Band Basics:

These are week long camps that will take place in July. Enjoy a week of camaraderie and the fun of self-expression through music.

Busing:

Kaukauna will offer busing to and from summer school for a fee. The cost is still being determined. Students will be dropped off at Kaukauna High School **prior to the start of the first class at 8:00 a.m.** Buses will return students **after classes end at 12:00 p.m.** If your child will be taking the bus to school and home after the last session, your child must be registered for all three sections as there is not supervision available in the commons during class time. Classes that fall outside of the 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. timeframe will not have a busing option. To register your child for busing, you will need to select the course called **Transportation – Busing.**

High School Credit Recovery:

Students who have previously failed a course required for graduation or are credit deficient may register for HS Credit Recovery Course. Registration for credit recovery courses will be open until June 7th. Any questions, please contact your child’s counselor at Kaukauna High School at 920-766-6113.

Remedial 5K – 8th Grade Classes (Teacher Recommendation ONLY):

Remedial courses will be offered to students by invitation only. These courses will focus on Math and Reading remediation. They are designed to provide academic support for students who were identified by their teacher as needing extra instructional support. If your child has been recommended for a course, a letter will be sent home with your child. Eligible students will be referred by their teacher.



A Bridge to Advanced Math 7 (Teacher Recommendation ONLY):

This course will be offered to students by invitation only. This course is for a small group of students selected by sixth grade math teachers who meet the eligibility requirements. A Bridge to Advanced Math 7 is designed to assist students in gaining the necessary math skills needed to transition from Math Expressions 6 to Advanced Math 7. The skills entail various 7th grade math standards that were not covered within the Math Expressions 6 curriculum. By the end of the course, students will have the needed tools for success in Advanced Math 7.

Strength & Conditioning:

This course will be offered from June 11 through August 1. This class is designed to teach from the basics of speed and strength training to advanced training techniques. Cross training techniques for multiple sports, for both younger and older athletes. This class runs outdoors on the track at KHS as well as indoors, so proper shoes and clothing are necessary depending on weather conditions. Course fee is used for providing a snack after the section.

Kindergarten Kids – August 19 (1 day only) for Tanner only:

Kindergarten Kids will have a special opportunity to experience Kindergarten before it even starts! This course will be offered as a 4-hour session. Students will spend time in the Kindergarten classroom learning about what Kindergarten will look like, sound like and feel like. Students will be exposed to a variety of Kindergarten school experiences including: classroom meetings, recess, character traits and behavior expectations, snack and lunch procedures, and recess at Tanner School. Tanner 2019 - 2020 Kindergartners are encouraged to sign up for this course.



Summer Space STEAM Camp:

This camp will run from July 22 – July 25, from 8:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. at Tanner Elementary for students going into grade 4.

If you're looking for ways to engage your child in a new and exciting experience this summer, you've got to check out our Summer Space STEAM Camp! Kids imagine, collaborate, explore and create all while learning super cool STEAM skills! The Summer Space STEAM Camp combines Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math with space themed activities. Students will participate in age-appropriate activities geared toward instilling a passion for exploring and creative thinking all while learning about space.



Personal Wellness (for original credit):

Students will assess and interpret their state of overall wellness, as well as participate in activities that will improve their fitness level. They will spend time analyzing their own personal fitness data to create a plan that will improve areas of need with the ultimate goal of learning skills to develop lifelong wellness. Daily activities may include: strength training, cardiovascular training, flexibility training, yoga, meditation, stress-management, sports-based games, and healthy cooking demonstrations. Students can expect 60-70% of the day to be active and 30-40% of the day to be in the classroom.

This course is intended for students who either do not have room in their schedule for physical education due to the rigor of their course requests, or for students who have had challenges in a traditional physical education course. Students must have successfully completed their ninth grade physical education requirement prior to enrolling in this course. This course would fulfill .5 credit of the 1 credit that must be taken in Grade 10, 11 or 12.



Extended 4K (Teacher Recommendation ONLY):

This course is designed to give current 4K students the opportunity to continue their work on the basic skills necessary for their upcoming Kindergarten year. Students will have a lot of fun and meet new friends while working on counting, letters, writing, reading, social skills and more!

Course Descriptions (Tentative)



A Bridge to Advanced Math 7	Cost \$4.00
Description: 	<u>Students must be recommended for this course.</u> This course is for a small group of students selected by sixth grade math teachers who meet the eligibility requirements. A Bridge to Advanced Math 7 is designed to assist students in gaining the necessary math skills needed to transition from Math Expressions 6 to Advanced Math 7. The skills entail various 7th grade math standards that were not covered within the Math Expressions 6 curriculum. By the end of the course, students will have the needed tools for success in Advanced Math 7.
Academy of Wizardry	Cost \$12.00
Description:	Does the wizarding world intrigue you? Put on your cloak and grab your broom as we spend the summer exploring magical phenomena, concocting science potions, studying spells, and creating bewitching arts and crafts!

<p><u>Advanced Drum Line</u> Description:</p>	<p>No Cost Not to be taken lightly by the weak hearted, this class will explore the world of creating a drum line. This week long intense course will explore the intricacies of how cross accents, "through-ups" and other drum techniques make the music come alive. The basics of motion, beat, form, technique, dynamics and duration will be emphasized and drilled. Enjoy a week of camaraderie and the fun of self-expression through music.</p>
<p><u>Animal Safari</u> Description:</p>	<p>Cost \$5.00 Come travel around the world as we explore different animals from each continent and the ocean. Students will document their findings in their own journal, chart their travels on a map, and create a souvenir to remember their adventures! Please Note: All new ANIMALS will be studied this summer!</p>
<p><u>Art & Athletics</u> Description:</p> 	<p>Cost \$8.00 This class is the perfect blend of everyone's favorite specials (art and physical education). For the art portion, students will be creating projects from step-by-step instructions to imaginative art. For the physical education portion, the created project will be incorporated into active games and activities.</p>
<p><u>Band Lessons</u> Description:</p>	<p>No Cost Students will attend a 20-minute lesson once a week for summer school starting June 11 - June 28 and July 8 - July 26. Families will be emailed a Sign-Up Genius in early spring to reserve their specific lesson time. The goal of these lessons is to help students maintain muscle tone and improve instrumental performance skills. Current Kaukauna band students will receive summer lesson information from their instructor. Please note students will not be able to leave another summer school course to attend their band lesson.</p>
<p><u>Baseball Fundamentals & Skills</u> Description:</p>	<p>No Cost Participants will learn fundamental skills of the game of baseball. Learning and drills will be implemented on a weekly basis that will help enhance each player's success on the playing field. There will be fundamental activities to learn the basics of the game from base running, throwing, pitching, fielding, and hitting. We will also break into games and game-like activities on certain days.</p>
<p><u>Boys Basketball</u> Description:</p>	<p>No Cost Students will be introduced to terminology, skills, drills, and strategies of basketball. All students will be able to demonstrate their skill development through competitive game play.</p>

<p>Description:</p>	<p>This course is designed to help students in the following areas – physical development, underhand skill training, overhand passing fundamentals, ball movement training, 3 contact same side emphasis, 4 on 4 small court play and understanding and respecting differences among people in physical activity settings and maintaining a health-enhancing level of physical fitness will be stressed.</p>
<p><u>Color Guard Basics</u></p>	<p>No Cost</p>
<p>Description:</p>	<p>Come join the fun of creating motion to music in various ways through art of flag twirling. This week long intense course will open your eyes to the world of visual expression with special emphasis on popular marching music. The basics of motion, beat, form, and duration will be presented and drilled. Enjoy a week of camaraderie and the fun of self-expression through music.</p>
